The Club Seabirds will be available for charter to the members for the above Championship on the following basis:

1. **The Standard Boat Requisition form** must reach Hon. Sailing Secretary, Royal Bombay Yacht Club, latest by 7.00 pm. on Monday 9th, April 2007.
2. The draw for the boats will take place on Monday, 9th at 7.00 p.m. at Royal Bombay Yacht Club. All the intending members are requested to remain present. However, the draw will take place in any case at 7.00 p.m. in the presence of the Officers of the Club. This draw will decide which members will be allotted the boats and a second draw for the boats will be made immediately thereafter.
3. The fee for the charter *will be* Rs. 300/- per boat for the duration of the Championship.
4. The allottees may tune the boats to their liking after the allotment and prior to the Championships. However, normal boat hire fees will be charged for the boat used on any day preceding the Regatta.
5. The Charter fee will be debited to the members bills.
6. The helmsmen will be responsible for the boat and any damage to the boat during the Regatta will be made good by the helmsmen.
7. The helmsman may not carry out any alterations or modification to the boat without prior permission from Captain of boats, Royal Bombay Yacht Club or Captain of boats, BSA/ CSC (as the case may be).
